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## Basic Excel Terminology

## $\Rightarrow$ Active Cell

The active cell is the cell surrounded by a black border. The black border is referred to as the active cell highlight
$\Rightarrow$ Cell Reference
A cell reference identifies the location a cell or group of cells in the spreadsheet.
$\Rightarrow$ Formula
A spreadsheet formula is a mathematical equation that will calculate a result.

Examples of simple formulas: = A3-C6 /
D2 or = ( B4 + B5 ) * E7
$\Rightarrow$ Function
A function is a preset formula.

Like formulas, functions in Excel begin with the equal sign ( $=$ ) followed by the function's name and its arguments.

## Excel/ Spreadsheet

## Overview

$\diamond$ A spreadsheet application is a computer program such as Excel, Open Office Calc, or Google Docs Spreadsheets.
$\checkmark$ Excel has a number of built in features and tools, such as functions, formulas, charts, and data analysis tools that make it easier to work with large amounts of data.
$\diamond$ A spreadsheet is a file used to store various types of data.
$\diamond$ The basic storage unit for a spreadsheet file is atable.
$\diamond$ In a table, the data is arranged in rows and columnsto make it easier to store, organize, and analyze the information.
$\diamond$ In Excel an individual spreadsheet file is referred to as a workbook.
$\checkmark$ A term related to this is worksheet, which, in Excel, refers to a single page or sheet in a workbook. By default, Excel has three worksheets per workbook.
