

### Basic Components of an Excel Document



#### **Basic Excel Terminology**

⇒ Active Cell

The **active cell** is the cell surrounded by a black border. The black border is referred to as the *active cell highlight* 

⇒ Cell Reference

A cell reference identifies the location a cell or group of cells in the spreadsheet.

⇒ Formula

A spreadsheet formula is a mathematical equation that will calculate a result.

Examples of simple formulas : = A3 - C6 / D2 or = ( B4 + B5 ) \* E7

⇒ Function

A function is a preset formula.

Like formulas, functions in Excel begin with the equal sign ( = ) followed by the function's name and its arguments.

## Excel/ Spreadsheet Overview

- A spreadsheet application is a computer program such as Excel, Open Office Calc, or Google Docs Spreadsheets.
- Excel has a number of built in features and tools, such as functions, formulas, charts, and data analysis tools that make it easier to work with large amounts of data.
- A spreadsheet is a file used to store various types of data.
- ♦ The basic storage unit for a spreadsheet file is atable.
- In a table, the data is arranged in rows and columnsto make it easier to store, organize, and analyze the information.
- ♦ In Excel an individual spreadsheet file is referred to as a workbook.
- A term related to this is worksheet, which, in Excel, refers to a single page or sheet in a workbook. By default, Excel has three worksheets per workbook.
